

NOTE FOR THE AUTHORS

1. The Monitoring of Law Enforcement academic peer-reviewed journal considers and publishes scholarly papers on problems in the field of law and sociology. The academic policy of the journal is geared towards the requirements of the Higher Attestation Commission under the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation and international professional standards as well as appropriate ethical standards.
2. There are no publication charges. No fees are paid to the authors. Submitted manuscripts are not returned to the author.
3. Papers are published “as is”, without any additional academic editing and proof-reading. The editorial office controls all mandatory attributes of a scholarly paper (abstract, keywords, information on the authors, references, as well as the translation of these attributes into English and transliteration of references in the Latin alphabet); if they are incomplete or machine-translated into English the publication may be refused.
4. An application submitted by e-mail means the author’s consent to transfer his/her rights to the paper if it is published as well as a confirmation of accepting the policy of the journal, open publication of the materials in the author’s paper and its reviews, including the personal data provided by the author unless the latter is specifically otherwise provided in a separate application by the author.
